


History: the beginnings of Rome

(N.D) Rome was located at the point of contact between three important countries












The concept of the City Master Plan that identified the main communication and rail routes and divided the city into zones;



Framework of the new Rome Master Plan





Addition of a new core Downtown region for more expansion








Projects Urban Wet Meadow canal
